Under N.J.S.A. 18A:38-1(c), any person who fraudulently allows a child of another person to use his residence for entry in the local public school system and is not the primary financial supporter of that child commits a disorderly persons offense and is liable to a maximum jail term of six (6) months and to a maximum fine of \$500.00, or both.

Under N.J.S.A. 18A:38-1(b), any person who allows a child of another person to use his residence for entry into the local public school system where such a child is not entitled by law to a free public education in the local public school system will be liable for tuition to the local public school district.
